

Lady Tigers Down Odessa on Home Court

The Warrensburg Lady Tigers (9-12) earned a hard-fought victory over the Odessa Lady Bulldogs (6-14) on Friday night in Warrensburg. This was the Lady Tigers' second conference win of the 2020-21 season.

It was a defensive effort for most of the first quarter as the Lady Tigers outscored Odessa 5-4. Warrensburg's offense came to life with a couple of three-pointers from Brooklyn Becker and then seven more points from Sammy Fatka to give the Lady Tigers a 21-11 going into halftime.

"We probably played one of our best defensive games in a while in the first half", said Coach Keith Chapman.

The Lady Tigers were able to maintain a nine-point lead in the third quarter by holding Odessa to just seven points. The offensive effort was led by Kimberly Maxwell as she dropped 10 points in the second half to help pace Warrensburg to a 38-31 victory.

Coach Chapman praised Maxwell for her effort in the second half. "Kimmy kind of took over in the second half and got some layups and some shots around the basket", Chapman said.

Maxwell led the Warrensburg offense with 14 points. Livie Burson had a solid night with nine points including a three pointer and four free throws. Fatka chipped in seven points while Becker added six points of her own. Bella Valdez also chipped in two free throws.

The Lady Tigers travel to Oak Grove on Monday night with a tip off at 5:30 pm. Warrensburg then returns home versus Clinton on Tuesday and round out their regular season with Center on Thursday.
